

Midwest native. Hardy in heat and humidity. Can tolerate a range of soil conditions. Pyramidal shaped canopy. Fall color: yellow.

## Deciduous Trees

### Bald Cypress

*Taxodium*

#### Bald Cypress

Native to southern swamps and up the Missouri River Valley. Thrives in wet soils, but adapts extremely well to a wide range of soil conditions. Tolerates occasional flooding. Soft, feathery needles defoliate in the winter. Does bear cones. Fantastic wildlife habitat. Fall color: rust.

#### 'Lindsey Skyward'

Dwarfed version of the bald cypress. Branches grow upright to form a narrow canopy. Retains the hardiness and adaptability of a bald cypress. Non-aggressive root system. Fall color: copper.

*Betula nigra 'Cully'*



Multi-stem. Papery white and peach toned peeling bark on trunks. Thrives in wet soils. Extremely heat tolerant. Exceptionally fast growing. Small, green foliage through the summer. Fall color: yellow.

#### Royal Frost

*Betula 'Royal Frost'*



Multi-stem. Peeling white bark along trunks. Foliage is burgundy-purple through the growing season. Less tolerant of heat than the 'Heritage' variety. Benefits from some partial shade. Exceptionally fast growing. Fall color: Orange-red.

### Chokecherry

*Prunus*

#### Canada Red

Native across North America. Extremely hardy, tolerating extreme heat, cold, wind, and varying moisture levels. New leaves emerge green, then change to burgundy throughout the growing season. White blooms in spring followed by small black fruits. Fall color: Burgundy

### Cottonwood

*Populus*

#### Siouxland Cottonwood

Native to Kansas. Male, cottonless trees. Extremely fast growing. Adaptable to wide range of soil types.

Cold and heat hardy. Useful for creating windbreaks, stabilizing slopes, and naturalizing areas. Fall color: yellow.

### Crabapple

*Malus*

#### Raspberry Spear

*Malus x 'JFS-KW213MX'*

Upright, tightly columnar tree. Deep pink flowers bloom on bare branches in early spring followed by red fruits. Foliage gains a burgundy hue throughout the growing season. Small, ornamental tree perfect for small areas or front yards. Fall color: Orange-bronze.

#### Royal Raindrops

*Malus x 'JFS-KW5'*

One of our most popular trees. Rounded, umbrella canopy. Sturdy branches—handles wind well. Bright, magenta flowers bloom on bare branches in early spring followed by red fruits. Purple foliage throughout the growing season. Fall color: Burgundy

Dwarf tree with dense, pendulous branches. White flowers bloom on bare branches followed by red fruit. Green foliage. Small ornamental accent tree ideal for entryways or small gardens.

Arching, vase shaped canopy. Small leaves give the canopy a fine texture. Peeling bark on mature trees. Resistant to Dutch Elm Disease. Tolerant of a wide range of conditions. Fall color: yellow-rust red.

Pyramidal to vase shaped canopy. Small glossy green leaves. Great shade tree for front yards or along streets. Resistant to Dutch Elm Disease. Tolerant of a wide range of conditions. Unique fall color. Fall color: burgundy-purple.

Pyramidal canopy is extremely symmetrical with a strong central leader. Dark green foliage. Low maintenance tree with no litter. Excellent street or yard tree. Fall color: yellow.

#### Bracken's Brown

Cold hardy Southern style magnolia. Evergreen foliage is thick and waxy. Deep green leaves with soft brown undersides. Large creamy white blooms in late spring. Pyramidal shape. Branches to the base.

Upright, narrow canopy. Blooms white in early spring on bare branches followed by small brownish fruits. Green foliage through the growing season. Superior to 'Bradford' pears in that they do not produce an odor and are less prone to branches breaking.

### Cotton Candy Redbud

*Cercis canadensis 'John Sjo'*

Baby pink blooms in early spring on bare branches. Large, glossy, heart-shaped leaves. Introduced to the market by Blueville Nursery. Fall color: yellow.

*Early, large flowering varieties: double, semi-double, & mid-season clematis*

Produces flowers on old or previous season's stems. Pruning this group should be done in April or early May. Remove all dead and weak stems, then simply trim the remaining stems enough to keep it under control. All remaining stems need to be tied to give space for new growth.

#### Group 3: Hard Pruning

*Varieties flowering on new season's growth*

Old previous season's growth naturally dies back each winter. Therefore, all old growth must be removed to allow for new growth. Prune this group in late April or early May.

Pruning consists of removing all old top growth down to ~12-18."

### Newly Planted Clematis

Regardless of flowering habit, all newly planted clematis should be pruned hard, 12-18" off the ground the first spring after planting. This will encourage a sturdier, more heavily branched base making the vine more durable.

### Best Planting Practices

**Container Plants:** Dig the hole about 6-8 inches wider, and as deep as the root ball. Remove your plant from the container and cut vertically along the root ball. This will help the roots realize they are out of the container and can begin spreading out.

Place your plant in the hole, be sure the root ball is even with or slightly above ground level. Planting too deep can cause the roots to drown. See that you have the plant facing the direction you want. Now you can begin to back fill with 1/2 soil amendment and 1/2 soil from the hole. You want to water as you're back filling, "stirring" the soil mix and water as you go. This will help prevent any air pockets and help secure your plant in place by settling the soil. Apply root stimulator.

**Ball & Burlap Trees:** Dig the hole 2 times wider than the diameter of the root ball with sloping sides to allow for proper root growth. Dig deep enough so the trunk flare sits slightly above ground level with most of the roots to be buried 1-2 inches beneath the soil. It's always better to plant slightly too high than too deep. See that you have your tree facing the direction you want. Now you can begin to back fill with 1/2 soil amendment\* and 1/2 soil from the hole. Water as you are back filling, "stirring" the soil mix and water as you go. This will help prevent any air pockets and help secure your tree in place by settling the soil. Apply root stimulator.

**Mulch & Stake:** You will want to mulch around your trees, 2 to 3 inches deep, leaving 1 to 2 inches clearance between the trunk and the mulch, in a 3 foot radius around the tree. This will protect it from weeds and equipment. Stake your tree to stabilize it and let the tender roots really dig and grow in to the ground.

After initial watering, check your plants for water every day to every other day for the first few weeks, watering when necessary. A slow, deep soak to the soil is best.

Not enough water is harmful to your plant, but too much can do damage as well. The best way to judge is by feel. You want the soil to feel damp, but not soggy, 2 inches below soil level. Using a root stimulator every 2 to 3 weeks during the first two growing seasons is highly recommended as well.
