Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

Crown shape: narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness
